

Bay City ISD ESSER III Plan 2021-2023

Bay City ISD will apply to receive \$10,545,891 in Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief III (ESSER III) funds.

- 20% of the ESSER III funds must be reserved to address the academic impact of loss of instructional time through the implementation of evidenced-based interventions – *BCISD has reserved \$7.8 million to address the learning loss of our students*
- *Blackcat Blueprint* will serve as the required Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services (RIPICS) Plan - to be reviewed every 6 months with stakeholder input
- BCISD will provide summer school, extended day, and Saturday school to meet the comprehensive needs of our students.
- BCISD will provide evidence based intervention programs and intervention personnel to address the learning loss of special populations identified in the needs assessment.
