Blackcat Tailgating Guidelines & Rules

LIMIT 1 VEHICLE PER SPOT – EXTRA GUESTS MAY USE BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL PARKING LOT AND WALK TO YOUR SPOT

1. Tailgating is allowed at the South end of New Memorial stadium outside the fence between the home stand and the southwest corner.
2. Tailgate area will open 2 and half hours before kick-off. Kickoff 7 = 4:30 / 7:30 = 5
3. Fans can obtain up to three parking permits for additional tailgating area.
4. RVs are NOT allowed.
5. Barbeques in tow will count as two permits – **NO GRILLING IN SPORTS 1-5**
6. Open flames are allowed but fans must extinguish their flames before entering Memorial Stadium
7. Tents are allowed, but must be taken down before entering Memorial Stadium
8. Memorial Stadium and Bay City ISD and its property will conform to all state laws. **NO ALCOHOL OR SMOKING IS PERMITTED.** Violation of state law could result in arrest or citation.
9. Your area must be clean before entering Memorial Stadium; or if continuing after game cleaned before you leave.
10. Entrance is through the yellow gates by the softball outfield. Tailgaters will pack into parking spot allowing distance for grilling in-between vehicle and fence.
11. Fee - \$20. Per spot – paid with cash or check made payable to BCHS Football.
12. Tickets will be required to enter the game. **NO RE-ENTRY** to game allowed.
13. In the event of rain – permit will be transferred or refunded
14. Porta Potties will be provided.

Fire Safety

1. Charcoal: Must be Match Light or Quick Light; use of starter fluid is prohibited; provide a metal pan under BBQ pit to prevent ashes from falling onto the ground
2. Trash: Keep your area clear of trash; avoid allowing trash to accumulate around BBQ pits; deposit trash in cans provided
3. Keep combustible materials at least three feet away from pits; placement of pits should be such that passers-by cannot come into contact with the pit; watch for children playing in area; do not leave burning pits unattended; do place hot pits or coals under your vehicle; allow time for pits to cool
4. Generators: Use of generators is allowed, however fuel must be stored in approved metal safety cans
