As we move into a long-term school closure, the Linnie Roberts teachers have been preparing to provide instruction in a digital format through Google Classroom beginning Monday, April 6th. In Google Classroom, the students will be able to see assignments, post responses, ask questions, and receive feedback from the teacher. We encourage you to help your student submit assignments through Google Classroom, but assignments will not be graded. Teachers will provide feedback to students regarding progress at least once weekly.

Please note that you must be signed into **your student's account** to access the classroom information. Students will need to add the specials classroom. The codes for those classes are:

classroom.google.com
Go to the Classroom website and log in with your Google Apps email login.


- 2

Join a Class
In the upper right click on the plus button to join a class. Enter the class code.



Install the Google Classroom App
- 3

Stream
Find your assignment in the Stream.

- 4

Open Templates
From the stream always click on "OPEN" in an assignment to view templates the teacher has attached.



Private Comments
For each assignment there is a private comment. Click on open and locate at the bottom of the assignment.
Use this to ask a question or have a conversation with your teacher to further your learning.
- 5

Turn In
Click the blue Turn In or Mark As Done button.



Parents are encouraged to continue working with your students according to the recommended times outlined below. We recommend dividing your time and working through assignments in smaller “chunks” throughout the week, and not done all at once.

Reading/Language Arts	90 minutes per week
Math	60 minutes per week
Science	30 minutes per week
Social Studies	30 minutes per week
Specials	30 minutes per week





ZOOM Meetings

You can participate in the meetings via a computer, using the link given to you by your teacher or you can download the Zoom app to access this from your mobile device. You do not need to create a Zoom account to be able to participate.




Zoom Directions for Students

FOR **COMPUTER** USERS: 🎧 Headphones help with background noise!

Google Chrome 55.0.2795 or higher, Internet Explorer 10 or higher, Microsoft Edge 39.14100.0.0 or higher, Google Chrome 50.0.2715 or higher, Safari 10.0.0.0.0 or higher, Firefox 49.0 or higher

1. Click on the meeting link your teacher sends or posts.	
2. If you have never used Zoom before then you will need to click <i>download and run</i> Zoom. If you have Zoom downloaded on your computer then click <i>Open zoom.us</i>	
3. You might see a similar message to the one on the right once Zoom has been launched. As soon as your teacher joins the meeting, the virtual room will pop up.	
4. Most likely your teacher has it set to mute all participants (that's YOU!) when they first join. You will only be able to hear your teacher at this time. She/he will not be able to hear you.	

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5. If your teacher invites you to speak, the message to the right may or may not pop up. If it does pop up click the blue Unmute Myself button.	
<p>Troubleshooting:</p> <p>What if my teacher cannot hear me?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bottom left corner next to the microphone, click the * arrow to try other microphones. <p>What if my teacher cannot see me?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bottom left corner next to the video camera, click the * arrow to try other cameras your computer may be connected to. 	
6. If you need to leave the meeting early or your teachers says the meeting has come to an end, you will want to exit the room by clicking Leave Meeting in the lower right hand corner.





Juntas por ZOOM



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Esperamos continuar conectándonos con sus estudiantes y brindarles apoyo durante este tiempo. Gracias por asociarse con nosotros.
