Performance Objective 3: The district will continue to improve the competitive salary structure to provide fair compensation to all employees with budgetary constraints.

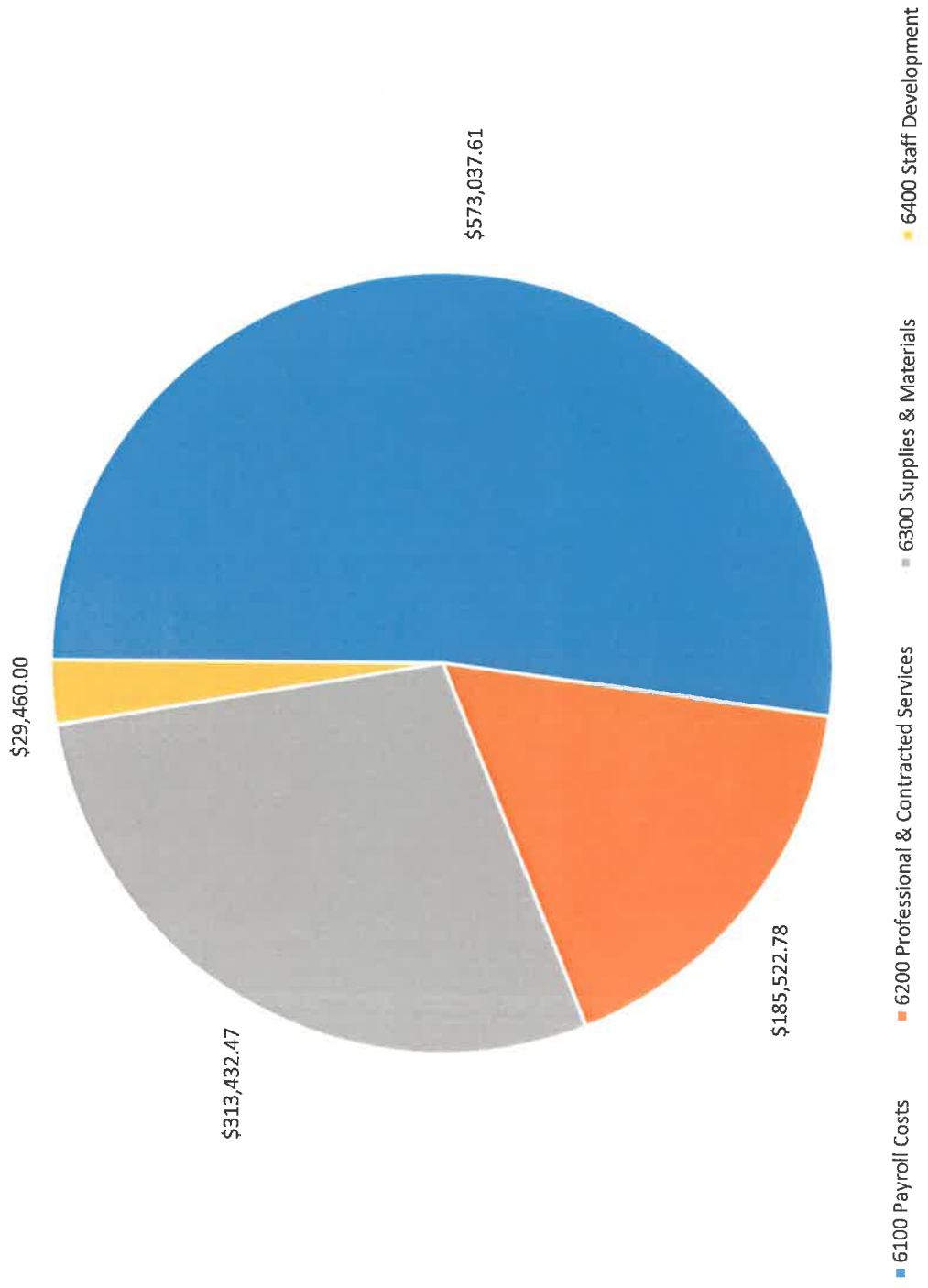
