  - Other students have registered to take the TSI
- ❖ Percentage of Applications
  - At Risk 43%
  - Economic Disadvantage 71%
  - African American 23%
  - Hispanic 51%
  - Males 43%

- ❖ Total number of parents coming to the Information Meetings - 70 parents
