Early College High School Lottery Procedures

Thank you for your interest in the Early College high School. Before completing the enclosed application, we request that you carefully consider the information below to determine if this program is the most suitable education experience for you/your child.

Bay City Early College High School's primary focus is on providing students from underrepresented backgrounds (i.e. at-risk, low income and/or first generation college attendees) the opportunity to earn up to 60 college credits free of charge while attending high school. As a designated Early College High School we must target students from underrepresented backgrounds; however, the Texas Education Agency rules and ECHS Benchmark 1, academics, discipline, state assessments and/or teacher recommendations cannot be considered in the selection process.

All applications that are complete and submitted by deadline will be considered for lottery. Entries will be weighted according to the following criteria. Applicants will receive one entry for each criteria met. A computer generated lottery application will be used to enter candidates and conduct selection of finalists.

1. At Risk Identification
2. Economically Disadvantaged Identification
3. ELL Identification
4. SPED/504 Identification
5. Attempted TSI Testing
